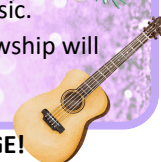

Advent Worship Music

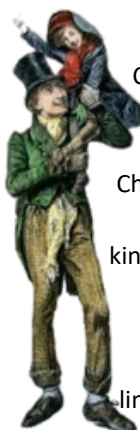
Sunday December 7, we welcome back Anna, Joseph, and Nathaniel for an afternoon of Advent Worship Music.
