

We begin the Lenten season Ash Wednesday which is February 18.

This is no greater time to deepen your faith than during Lent.

Mass times on Ash Wednesday at St. Joseph Church are 9:05am and 5:30pm.

Fr. will also offer drive through ashes in the front circle of the church from 12 noon-1:00pm. Holy Redeemer will have Mass at 7:00am on Ash Wednesday.

This is a day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics age 18-59.

Catholics age 14 and older are bound to observe abstinence of meat.

The tradition of Stations of the Cross will also continue Fridays at 6:00pm.
