America 250/ Sacred Heart Of Jesus

The U.S. bishops' decision to consecrate the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in 2026 (this week) is tied directly to the nation's 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. This act is both a spiritual gesture and a call to renew a faith-based patriotism that aligns with the Gospel. Pope Pius XI, in his encyclical Qui gaudent in Domino, praised the centuries-old practice of consecrating oneself, families, and even nations to the Sacred Heart as a way to recognize Christ's kingship and the kinship between God and humanity. By consecrating the nation, the bishops are affirming that the United States is called to live under Christ's reign.

The consecration invites Americans to move beyond divisive nationalism toward a constructive patriotism—

love for the nation's history, traditions, and people, while respecting the rights of all nations and peoples.

The diocesan initiative invites individuals, families, parishes and ministries to spend time in Eucharistic Adoration, pray for the nation and participate in simple but meaningful acts of charity within their communities. Catholics are encouraged to commit to at least one hour before the Blessed Sacrament during the month long observance, while also embracing opportunities to serve others through works of mercy.

At St. Joseph Parish, we invite you to participate in the works of mercy "feed the hungry" by donating a dried good to the St. Joseph Soup Kitchen. Dry goods include: pasta, rice, macaroni and cheese, boxed potatoes, egg noodles etc. donations can be dropped off in the bin next to the parish office. Thank you!

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

Teach Children to Protect Themselves at Home Keeping kids safe starts at home. Talk to your children about simple ways they can protect themselves: Know who's at the door – Never open it for strangers. Keep personal info private – Don't share your name, address, or phone number with anyone you don't know. Emergency contacts – Make sure your child knows how to reach you and call 911 if needed. Safe boundaries – teach them to say "no" to anything that makes them uncomfortable. Online safety – Remind them not to share personal details or passwords online.
